


## Year-End Statistics (cont.)



In 2022, PERT assigned 291 cases to the caseload, which was 46% of the 634 referrals that PERT received during the year.

PERT has begun tracking data on W&I 8102 petitions, Gun Violence Restraining Orders, and disengagements. This data will be reported out for 2023.

PERT has also begun tracking the ages of the subjects referred. (see chart on page 9 labeled "Referrals by Age") 28% (181 of the 634 referrals) were identified as youth or transition-aged youth 25 years old and under. Adults aged 26-64 were the largest group and accounted for 58% (365 out of 634) of referrals. 11% (70 out of 634) were seniors ages 65 and older. 3% (18 out of 634) had unknown ages, as their identities were unknown at the time of the report.
